- Introduced redundancy and business-continuity and disaster-recovery practices where none previously existed.
- Proposed and drove system upgrades including out-of-band management and a centralized system-image repository to improve remote recovery and workshop consistency.
- Helped reduce comparable workshop repair turnaround from weeks to approximately 72 hours while using hot-swappable replacements to shield customers from the repair interval.
- Serve as Tier 3 escalation for remote software problems and specialized hardware returned to the workshop, including Linux computers and custom RF/SDR systems.
- Troubleshoot unfamiliar purpose-built computers from schematics and build documents, including PCB- and backplane-level investigation, and document failure patterns for management.
